Continue along the wildflower hills and meadows. There will be a dazzling view of Mt. Shasta, Mt. Lassen and the plush Sacramento Valley. You will also notice endless handmade rock walls, old-time cattle ranches tucked back in the rolling hills, as well as abundant wildlife such as birds, deer, and squirrels to name a few.

100 Mile will include about 6,300 ft. of climbing

There will be numerous rest stops along the way serving delicious local fruits, sports drinks, cookies and lots of cold water. The 60- and 100- milers will have a lunch stop with all of the above, plus scrumptious sandwiches. Dinner will be served at conclusion of the ride.

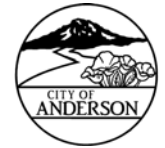

Remember...



- This is a ride, not a race.
- Helmets are required.
- Riders should carry an extra tube, patch kit, tools, and identification.
- Obey all "Rules of the Road" as printed in the California Vehicle Code Laws. A bicycle is a vehicle and subject to vehicle laws.
- Obey all signal lights and stop signs.
- Share the road with car drivers and leave their share clear for safe driving.
- Ride close to the right edge of the road.
- Ride single-file, particularly when traffic is present.
- Signal turns.
- Point out road hazards to other cyclists.
- Pass other cyclists on the left with the words, "On the Left"
